I will meet a member of staff.




They will show me around the GALLERIES and teach the GLASS WORKSHOP

activities for the day






National Glass Centre is a BIG buildingit is important to stay TOGETHER



In the galleries I will SEE glass art








I want to keep the art SAFE

Touching can DAMAGE the artwork







On my visit I will SEE gallery staff, they wear lanyards and name badges.

I will take part in a WORKSHOP, I will make some GLASS ART








I can use the LIFT to go between the floors, or use the STAIRS.





DOWNSTAIRS I can look around the shop If I have any QUESTIONS I can ask the shop staff for help






In the hot glass studio I can SEE artists make glass I can SEE a demonstration with commentary if I want to find out more
