

ARTS AWARD DISCOVER MODERATION GUIDE!



Congratulations on completing your Arts Award! We hope you have had a brilliant time learning some new skills, finding out new facts and sharing your journey with others.

At the end of each Arts Award there is a moderation which is where we get to find out what you have done and what you have learnt.

You will need to upload your information on the form to our website <https://sunderlandculture.org.uk/education/online-arts-award/>

Each child or young person who has completed an arts award will need to be inputted separately.

We will need the child or young person's full name, address, date of birth, gender and ethnicity, this allows us to input their details to Trinity College London to register their award.

You will be asked to answer a few questions on your Arts Award experience. This section can be completed by a parent/carer/guardian on behalf of the young person.

You will be asked:

What 2 things did you learn from doing your Arts Award?

What was your favourite bit of the Arts Award?

Would you be interested in taking part of more activities?

Do you have any feedback about your Arts Award journey?

You will then be asked to upload some of your work as evidence that you have done the tasks you said you have.

Please take a photos or scan the completed worksheets and anything you have created and upload them to the form. Please submit a piece of evidence from each section. If your child or young person has made a video as part of their arts award please email artsaward@sunderlandculture.org.uk You will need to submit this evidence for us to be able to moderate your Arts Award.

The first 250 moderations will be free but if you have signed up your place will be secure regardless of when you submit.
